When Keira gets to the health department meeting, she sees the woman she nearly ran over... it's her client.



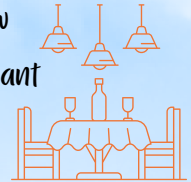
Emma Colton just moved to San Francisco from Chicago and is on her way to work when an impatient woman almost hits her with her car.

She doesn't tell Emma about her money problems because she's embarrassed, but Emma senses that something is going on and it worries her.



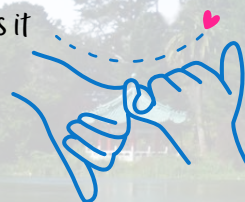
But Keira has a failing business, is losing clients, and her roommate and best friend is about to move out of the apartment they share. Keira doesn't know what to do.

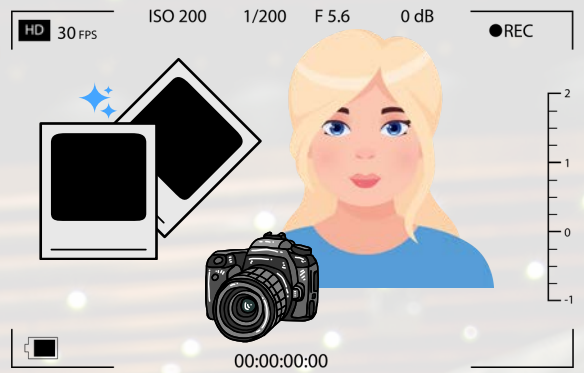

Macon decides to go on tour to give herself some time to think.

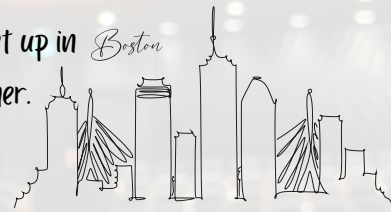

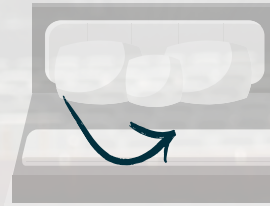
Joanna is upset, but she can't help how she feels, so they begin talking on the phone, trying to figure this out.

Hillary is a supportive girlfriend and they share a first kiss and their first time, which is Amara's first everything with a woman.

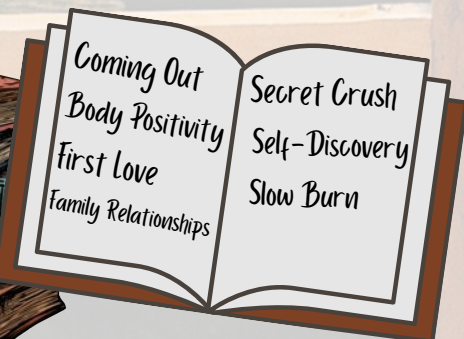
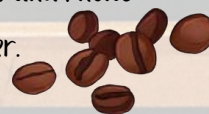
While at the Exploratorium with Hillary's friends, they run into Amara's father, who is now aware that his daughter is dating a woman.
