A detective appears and asks for Alyssa's help in finding out what really happened.

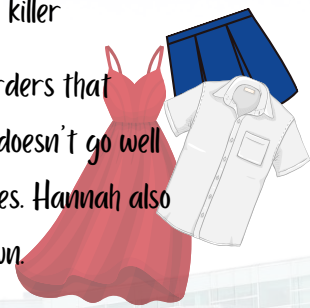


Alyssa and Rachel, the best friend and former girlfriend meet up for coffee to talk and run into Derek, Tyler's brother, who doesn't look so good.

Alyssa Masters was nearly convicted of a crime she didn't commit, but she's finally released. She has no home, no job, and no friends.

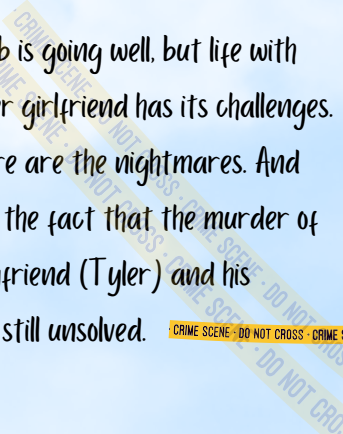


Hannah Granger returned from a trip abroad to a sick mother. After her mother's death, she needs to find a new job and a new place to live.

Ember Elliot works for her family's restaurant, helps at her brother's bar, and has a secret.



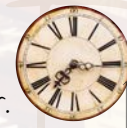
Eva Dash has only ever wanted to do two things. Work for the university that just fired her and fall in love.

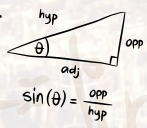
After running into Ember again, the two strike up a friendship where Eva begins to discover something unique about Ember.

Ember doesn't want anyone to know that she's actually a math genius because her family hasn't ever understood her anyway.

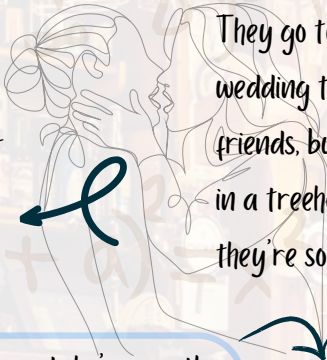


"I love you, Ember Elliot"

When Eva prods, Ember starts to think that she really could pursue her passion and starts looking into university programs.



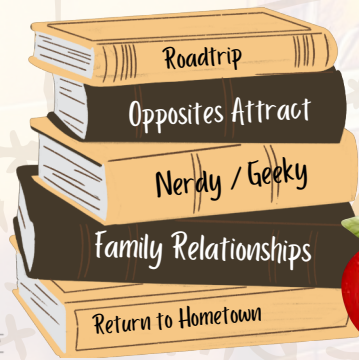
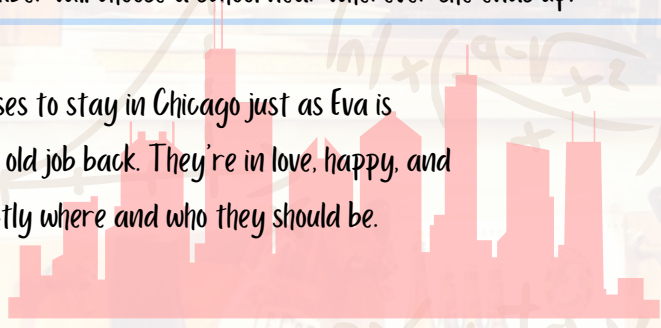
They go to Eva's sister's wedding together as friends, but after time some in a treehouse, they realize they're something more.

They both got scared about what this could be, but they also understand how important and real it is.

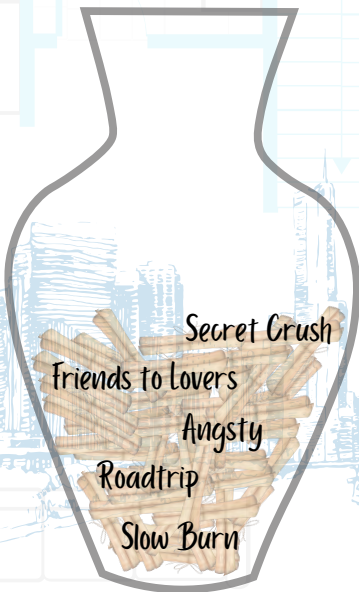
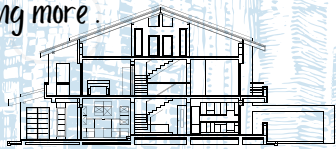


Charlie meets Summer Taft when she's in Michigan for a job and they kiss. When Charlie gets home, Hailey confronts her.

They're finally together after 10 years of friendship that was always meant to be something more.

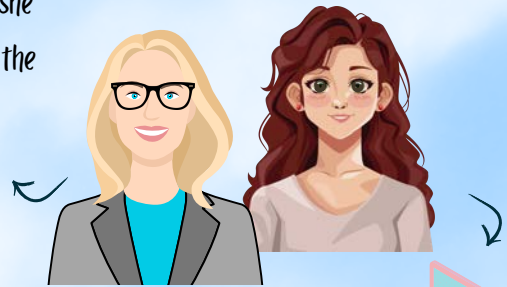


Who's this? You'll meet her later.

Lena Tanner dated Charlie before she finally got together with Hailey, but the two remained friends. Lena is only recently out (toaster oven) and is looking for love with a woman.



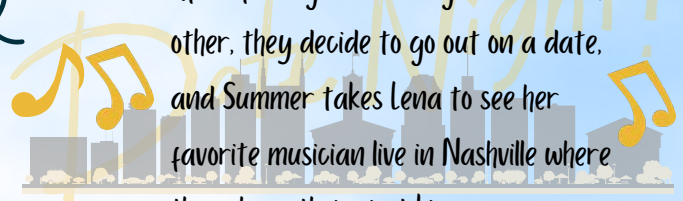
