When Palmer makes the move after some time, she finds out that she's on the Pulitzer short-list for her story on the new Queen.



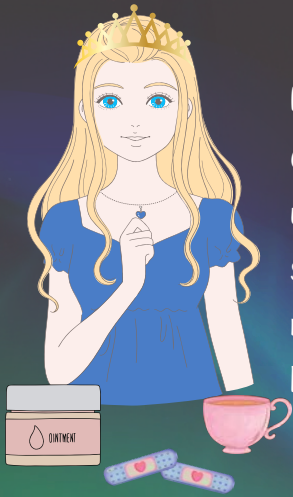

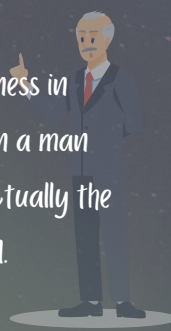

On top of Alex, Nora has to worry about Maxwell, who is interested in maybe one day being Alice's King Consort.



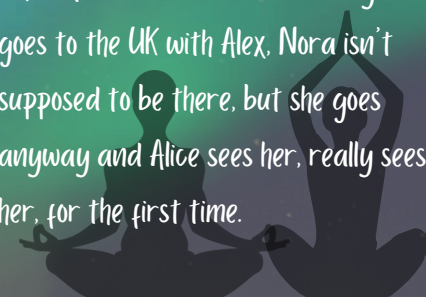
Nora remains on to protect her and hopes to bring an end to the President by reintroducing the monarchy, but she's still worried that Alice might not want to stick around.

Princess Alexandria, an out Princess, shows up to help. Nora is more than annoyed by the woman's obvious infatuation with Alice.

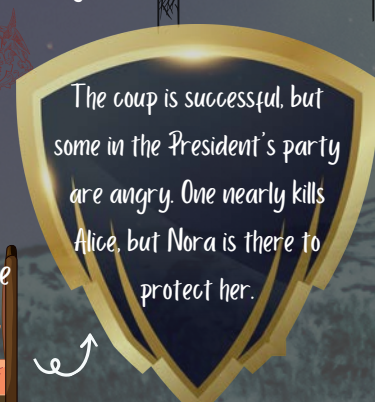
As Alice works on bringing much-needed resources to the country and letting the people get to know her, Nora and the others worry for her safety while planning to arrest the President.



When Alice needs some time away and goes to the UK with Alex, Nora isn't supposed to be there, but she goes anyway and Alice sees her, really sees her, for the first time.



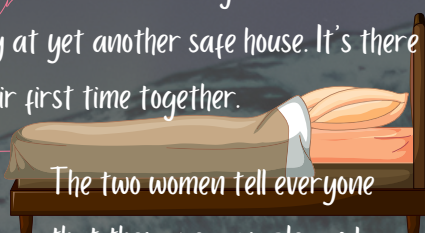

Alex and her mother have a talk about her love life. Alex talks to her father about Bexley being the one.

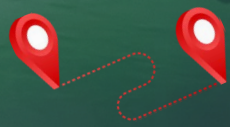
When they get there, Alex helps Bexley take care of her grandmother and then, she asks her to go to a hockey game where they flirt.
