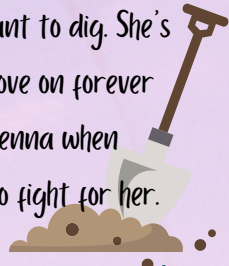
Ripley doesn't know what to make of Kenna and turns her down at first, but she still agrees to spend time with her.

Ripley doesn't want to dig. She's been trying to move on forever and risks losing Kenna when she's not willing to fight for her.



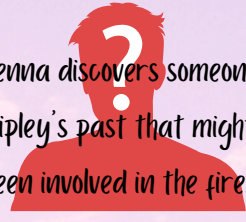
Ripley tries to let go of her past while beginning a present and maybe even a future with Kenna.

Kenna discovers someone from Ripley's past that might have been involved in the fire.



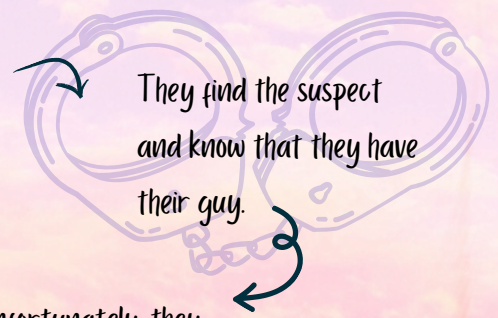
As the cops continue to investigate, they discover one suspect that stands out more than all the rest.

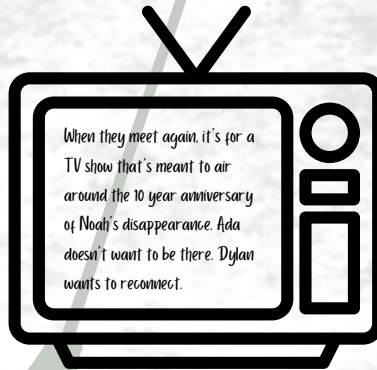
LINE - DO NOT CROSS -

It's on one of these nights that they have sex in the back office of that restaurant, finally giving into what they'd both been feeling since they reconnected.

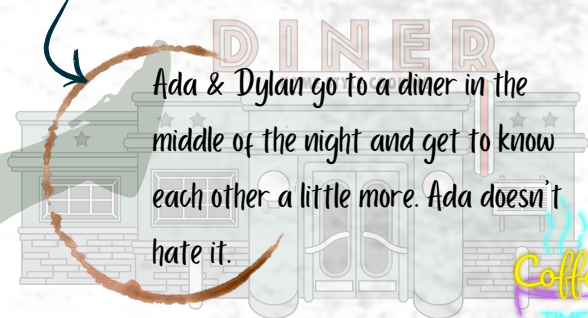

When the show airs, it brings out the people who like to torment others for fun, bringing Ada back to Dylan to find out who called her saying they know where Noah is.



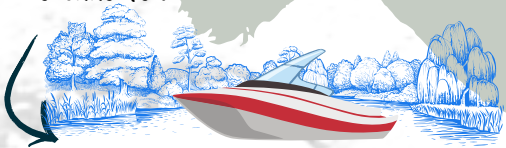
Dylan wants to keep an eye on Ada with all the new publicity surrounding the show and the disappearance, so she hangs out at the restaurant where Ada works.

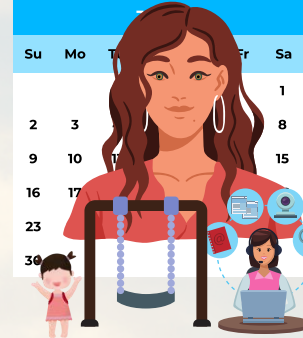

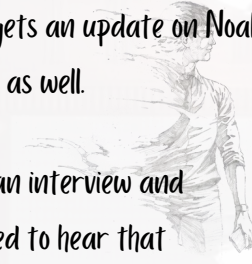
Carina needs to get Keiran's statement, and when she does, she's surprised at the woman's wit, intelligence, and beauty.
